**Sub: APPCB – CFE & CFO for manufacturing / formulation of sanitizers in the state of Andhra Pradesh - Reg.**

**Ref:** Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) outbreak in the State.

The Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board is issuing consent under Section 25 and 26 of Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and section 21 of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 for establishing the industry and regulating their outlet / discharges. The Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board deems it necessary to expedite the process of issuance of consent / permissions to the industries those wish to manufacture sanitizer. As a part of comprehensive system to handle the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) outbreak, availability of sanitizer or its production are to be ensured. The Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board deems it necessary that all the project / activity manufacturing sanitizer are considered as a priority activity as an interim measure.

**Now, therefore, the Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board in public interest hereby makes the following amendment in the process of granting CFE and CFO for manufacturing / formulation of sanitizers in the state of Andhra Pradesh:**

- Any existing sanitizer manufacturing unit can start sanitizer bottling activity immediately and apply for consent in 15 days.
- Any existing sanitizer bottling unit can start sanitizer formulation activity immediately and apply for consent in 15 days.
- Any existing distillery unit can start sanitizer formulation and / or bottling activity immediately and apply for consent in 15 days.
- Any other existing chemical / bulk drug manufacturing / formulation unit can start sanitizer formulation and / or bottling activity immediately and apply for consent in 15 days.

The project proponents can apply online on A.P. Single Desk Portal for grant of consent to establish and operate for above mentioned activities. All such proposals for manufacturing / bottling of sanitizers shall be considered on priority and **combined CFE & CFO order will be issued by the Zonal Officers of APPCB for a temporary period of two months. The above combined order will be issued in pollution control angle only. No CFE / CFO fee is required.**

This Circular comes into effect from the date of issue and shall be **in force till 31 May 2020** and shall be scrupulously followed by all the Officers of the Board.
